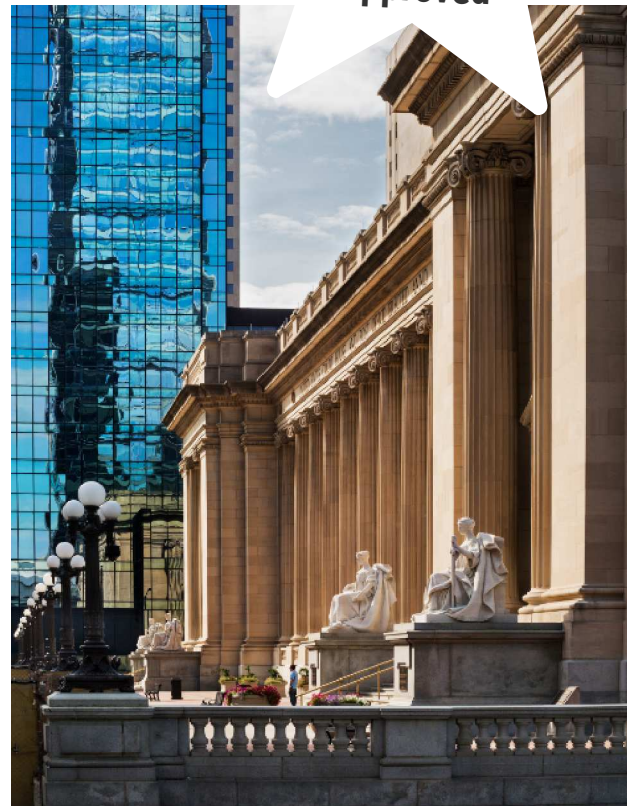
A LOOK BACK AT MARION COUNTY JAIL OVERCROWDING LITIGATION
